#### **School Overview**

Glocal Mission exists to lead people into God's mission by SEEKING the lost, DISCIPLING the found, and MULTIPLYING disciple makers and churches locally and globally. The Missionary Training School is designed to help you become an EVERYDAY missionary no matter where God has placed you, both locally and globally (see Acts 19:8-10). By the end of this training, you will learn to put into practice things like: holistic evangelism (addressing physical, emotional, relational, social, and spiritual needs), holistic discipleship (head, heart, hands, habits), community outreaches, cross-cultural ministries, as well as beginning new gospelcentered and Great Commission-driven ministries and church planting. The structure of this School will consist of weekly lectures/discussions that will take place on Tuesday and Thursday nights, three regional outreach projects will take place at the local level, and a short-term international mission trip is available. This School will offer a holistic and hands-on training experience by completing the above, as well as additional assignments. The desired outcome for the weekly lectures is to deepen your intimacy and relationship with our Missionary God by learning more about Him and His missions through Scripture. The urban outreaches and mission trips will enable us to put into practice what we learn in the classroom for the advancement of the whole gospel to the whole world by whole means with the mobilization of whole churches along with Rev. Dr. David Kim and Glocal Mission Pastors. Pastors are encouraged to engage key leaders in the school and supplement training as needed.

#### **School Fees**

This training school will be \$200. This fee covers Lecture Materials and Required texts. There may be a small fee for the Regional Outreach events collected regionally. Those going on the Mission Trip will pay for travel expenses and fees.

### **Projects and Assignments**

- 1. *Journal Entries*: A weekly journal entry is required to help you retain the information you are given during the lectures and reflect on how God is working in your life. The journal entry will simply be a summary of what you've learned during the week and a recap of how God moved in you and in others during your outreach.
- 2. *Weekly Preparation*: A weekly preparation including scriptures is assigned for you to do on your own time in preparation for each class. Reflection questions will follow after each module.
- 3. *Book Readings*: Two book readings are assigned for this training school to specifically dive deeper into how God is working in missions and how we can jump on board with Him.
- 4. *Short-Term Mission Trip*: We will complete a four-day mission trip partnering with an international Glocal Mission church plant. (Location TBD)
